



## Alternative Media Copyright Agreement

Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, requires institutions like WesternU to provide individuals with disabilities equal access to electronic information and data comparable to those who do not have disabilities, unless an undue financial or administrative burden would result. The following agreement is intended to protect the rights of the student, <sup>HF</sup>CDHP, and the publisher while being in compliance with the law.

- I understand that my signature may be shared by WesternU with the publisher of my alternative media for purposes of copyright information.
