<p>Lines of Inquiry</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lines of Inquiry – Key Points from WSCUC <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ WSCUC complimented the self-study as beautifully written. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Strengths noted: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strong alignment with institutional mission. • Visible steps toward improvement (e.g., KH Shared Governance project). • Clear evaluation and continuous-improvement processes. • Strong student-support investment (“all lines lead back to the student”). ○ Seven Lines of Inquiry for the Visit: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Use of evidence and evaluation. ▪ Institutional research & enterprise data (highlighted as “less standard” and of special interest). ▪ Assessment of learning outcomes (expected major focus). ▪ Faculty capacity and development (workload models, structure). ▪ Board of Trustees governance and accountability. ▪ Staff support and development efforts. ▪ Enrollment management (noting stable trends over last 4–5 years). ○ Institutional Research & Data Systems <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ New data-management structure being developed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IRE on analysis/reporting side. • Data management operations moved under IT. • Goal is to have modern, coordinated institutional data system. • WSCUC wants more detail; Satoko Siegel and Steve Eubanks coordinating. ○ Additional Evidence <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Matrix created to track supplemental evidence for each line of inquiry. ▪ Deadline for submitting additional evidence is January 21. ○ Staff Support Initiatives <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Meetings with Staff Council held to identify training needs and scheduling challenges. ▪ HR and CETL are collaborating on a development plan for staff training and engagement.
