The PharmD-MBA dual assurance program, offered cooperatively between College of Pharmacy at Western University of Health Sciences (WesternU) and Cal Poly Pomona's Singelyn School of Business, allows eligible WesternU Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) graduates to get a Master of Business Administration (MBA) in an accelerated time of only one additional year beyond their pharmacy education at a very affordable price.
